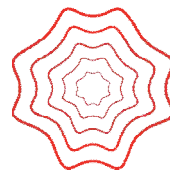

 - Technology

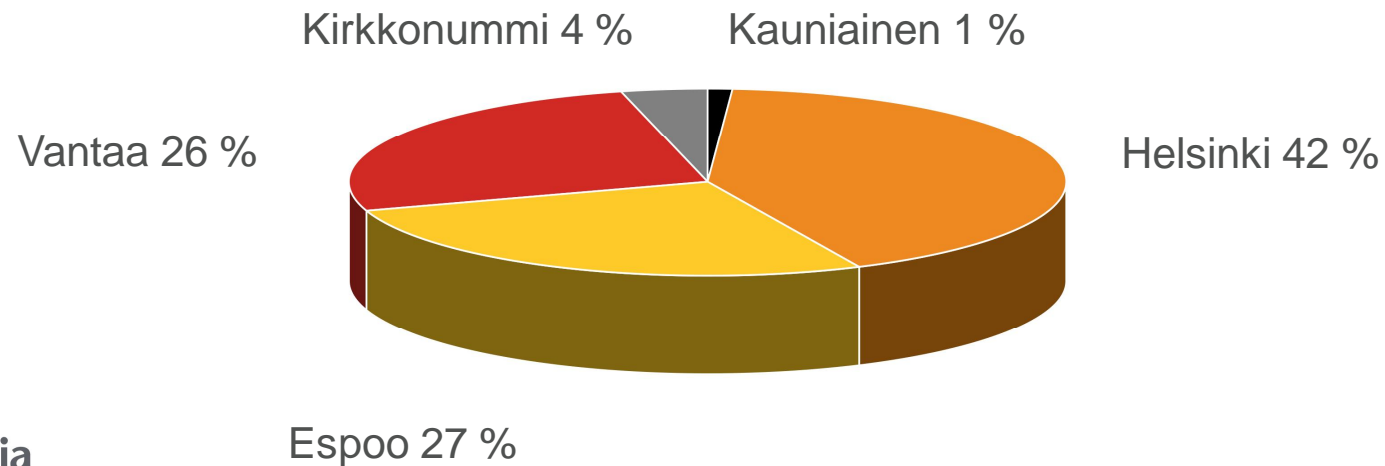

Metropolia in brief

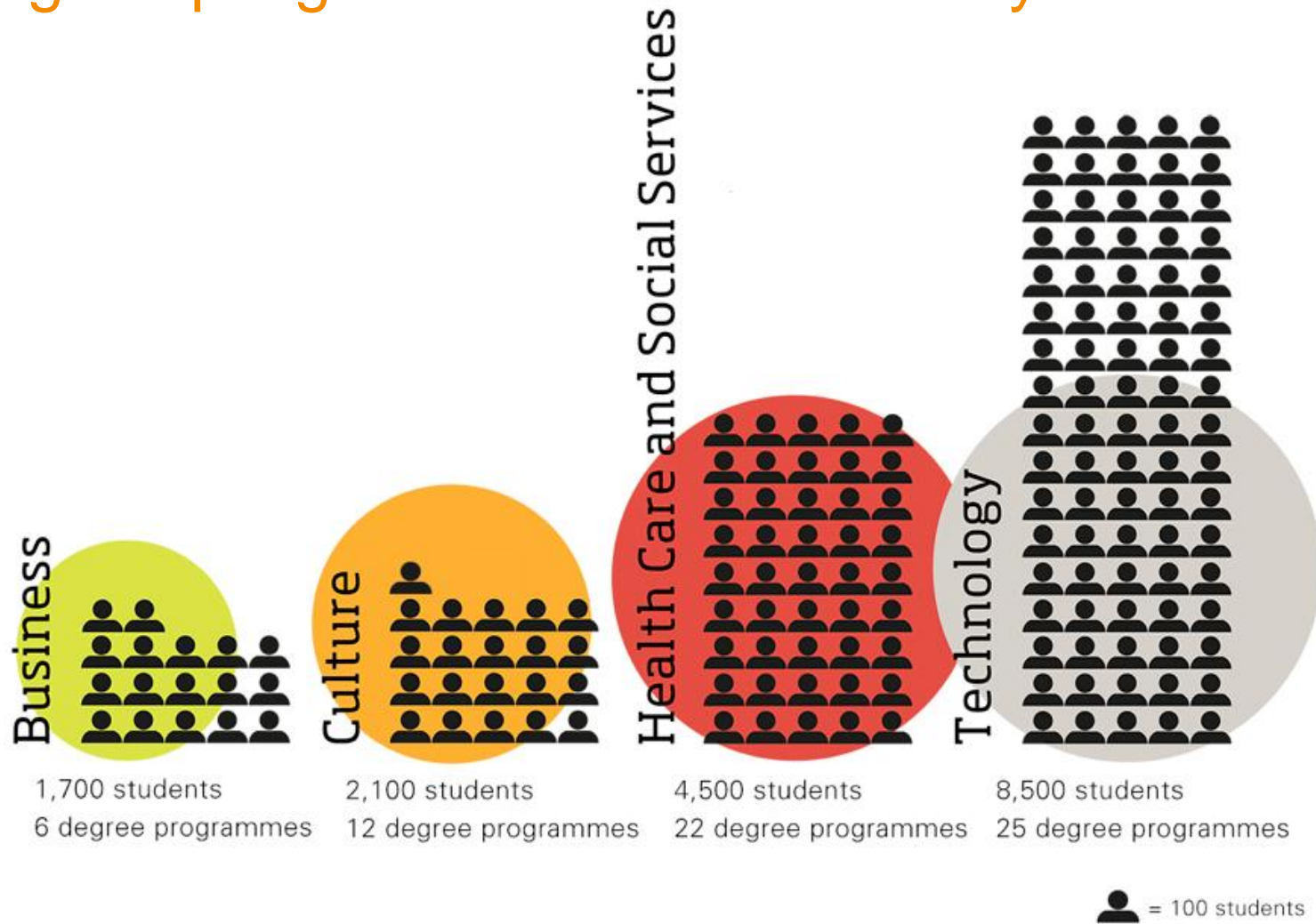
- Most popular UAS in Finland in terms of applicants, second-most popular in terms of attractiveness: 6.3 first-choice applicants per study place

International approach

- 15 of the 67 degree programmes are taught in English
- 400 partner institutions around the world
- 440 of our students go on exchange programmes of over three months every year, and 420 exchange students come to Metropolia

- 1300 foreign degree students, nearly 90 nationalities

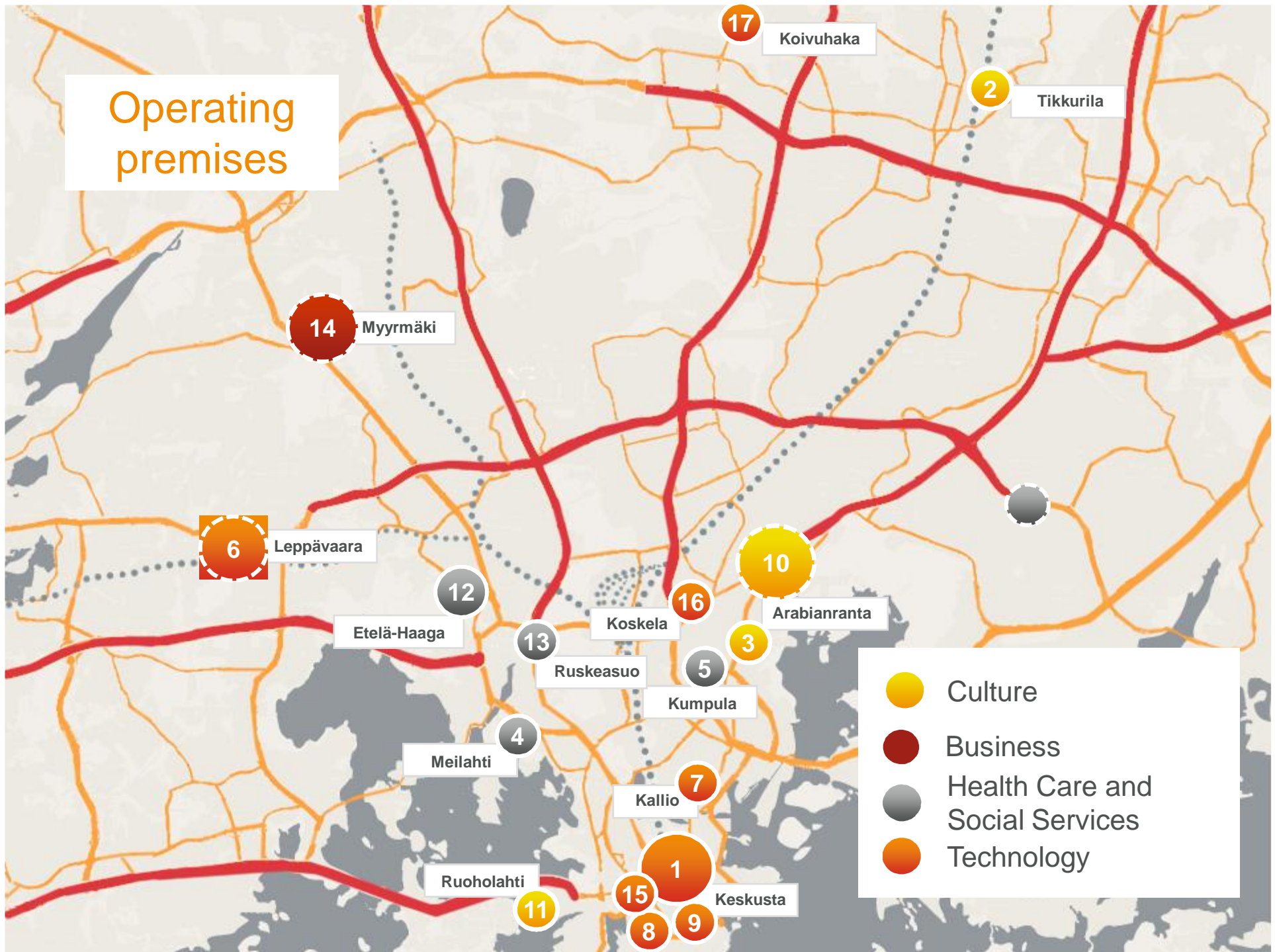

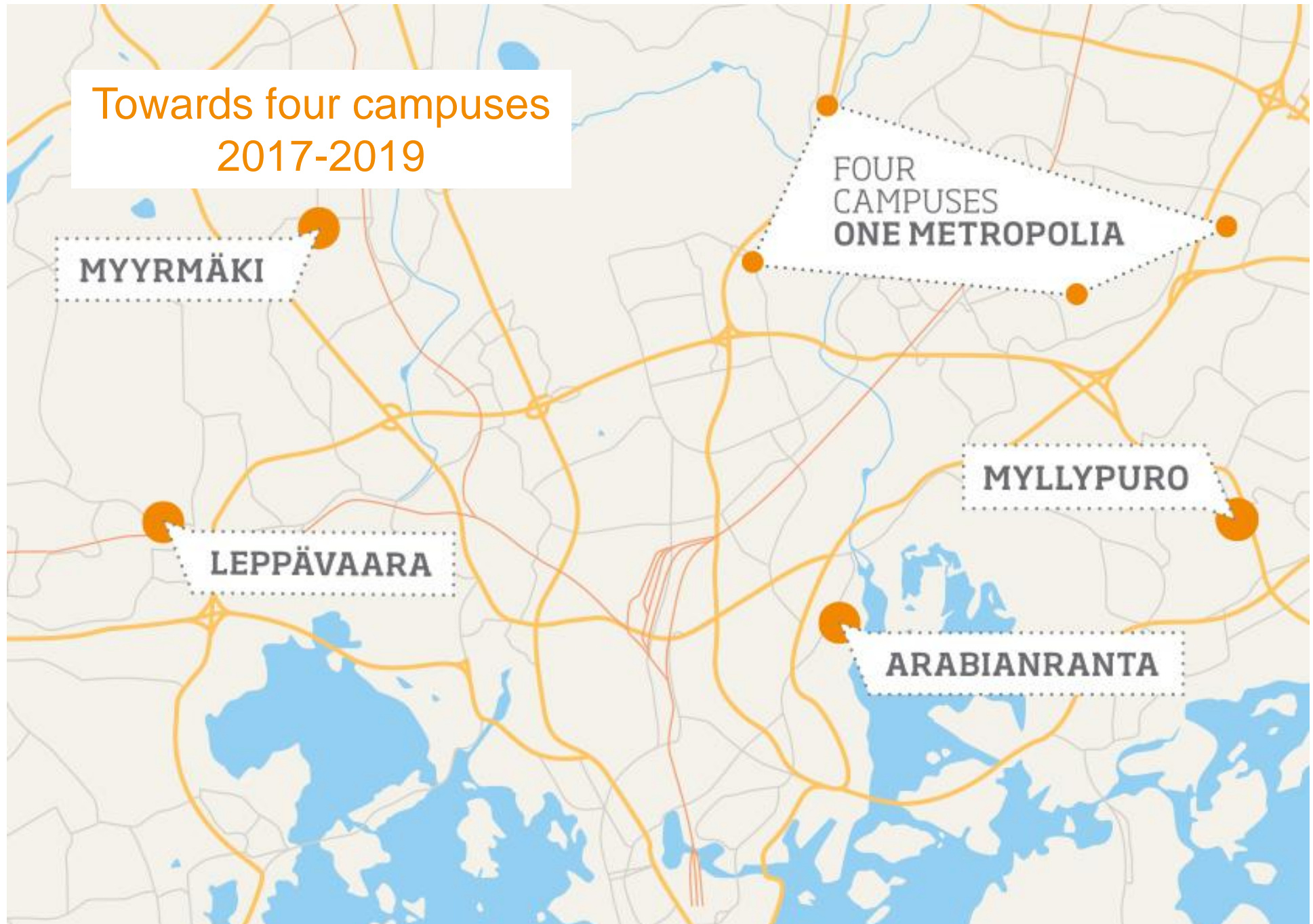

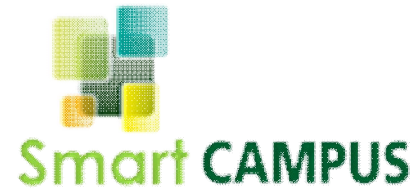
Operating premises
