PROJECT 10 ECTS

International Project Week (IPW) will take place on week 20 (May 16 - 20).

The theme for the week is Business Ethics. **IPW is compulsory part (2 ECTS) of course Innovation Project (10 ECTS).** Exchange students can select the course as an elective.

WHAT TO EXPECT

During the week student teams will get a chance to come up with solutions to real cases, provided by Finnish Red Cross. We will have visiting lecturers from our partner institutions lecturing and coaching groups during the week.

Below you can find short description of the two cases you will be working with during the week:

Assignment 1: Developing the Finnish Red Cross Friend Visitor activities

Loneliness is seen as one of the most significant problems in the Finnish society. Loneliness and the need for a friend and community exist in all age groups. An increasing number of elderly people continue to live at home longer. Loneliness is also connected to the experience of social exclusion and deprivation. Immigrants may need support in creating contacts in their new place of residence. In order to enable wellbeing and safe living in Finland, the Finnish Red Cross has organized Friend Visitor activities for decades.

We will need more volunteer friends to visit elderly people, be friends with young people, meet people living in institutions and prisons and to organize activities for people who have moved to Finland.

Assignment 2: Evaluating and developing the Finnish Red Cross Youth activities

Most of the Finnish Red Cross volunteers are middle-aged or older. The number of youth volunteers has increased, but the number of volunteers below the age of 29 remains rather low. Social media and new communication methods are in use but have not been able to reach masses of new volunteers. For example the concept of "digital volunteer work" has not yet been defined, but the need for innovation has been recognized.

In its current strategy, FRC has set an ambitious goal to double the number of volunteers and also the number of youth volunteers.

ATTENDANCE DURING IPW

Attendance is compulsory during the intensive week. In order to pass the course you need to be present. If you miss more than one day, the course is failed. (NB: Absence on Monday 16th May or Friday 20th May is not acceptable).

EVALUATION

IPW will be evaluated as pass or fail. Final grade for the whole Innovation Project 10 ECTS course will be graded with scale 0-5 based on your performance during the course. Passing grade from IPW part requires attendance and active participation.

ALTERNATIVE IMPLEMENTATION

If you are not able to commit to participate IPW (see strict attendance rules) you can complete this part with individual assignments. 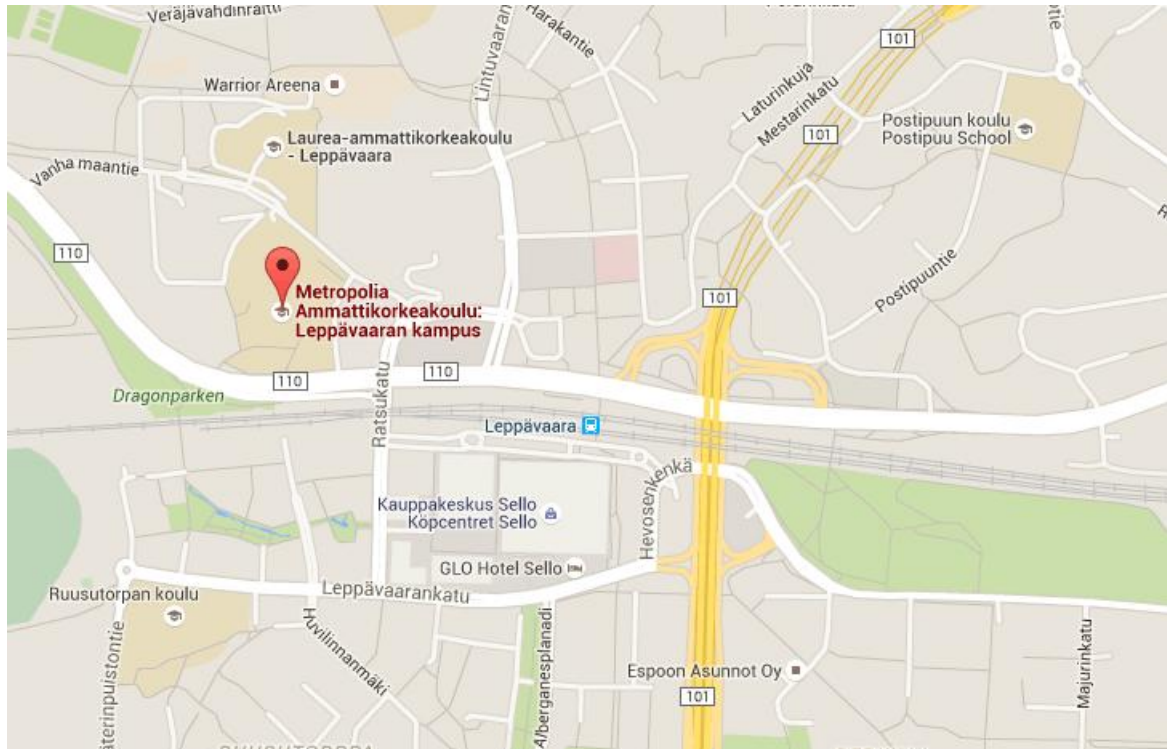
