Are older people using technology?


- Number of people +65 yrs using the internet is rapidly increasing

- Independent Living




Demographics of Scotland


The Scottish Government's 2020 Vision Future






Stroke





Definitions (Scottish Context)

- Telehealth
 - Provision of health services at a distance using a range of digital technologies. Examples: VC consultations to support diagnosis and management, clinical networks and health professional education.
- Telecare
 - Remote / enhanced delivery of <u>care</u> services to people in their own home. Usually refers to sensors and alerts which provide continuous, automatic and remote monitoring of care needs, emergencies and lifestyle changes, using ICT to trigger a response from carers, or to shut down equipment to prevent hazards.
- Telehealthcare: convergence between telecare and telehealth technologies to provide an integrated approach to the delivery of effective, high quality health and care services. It can be used to describe a range of care options available remotely by telephone, mobile phone, broadband and video conferencing.
