- School path is a partly year-round cycle and walk path for primary school children in Kivistö area.
- Designed to serve two current schools and future plans in the zoning plan. Concept might be used in any school paths in Finland and Europe.
- We use the knowledge and information the previous groups have done and improve it by adding more specific details and research.

WHAT TO STUDY AND HOW?


Find out elements that make school path fun and safe.
